All registered overnight guests at the Kalahari Treehouse Collection™ will also receive complimentary access to Kalahari’s award-winning indoor waterpark located just a few miles away.

The treehouses are being designed in partnership with [Pete Nelson and family](#), the former stars of Animal Planet’s “Treehouse Masters” for eleven seasons, and will celebrate the region’s natural beauty with each unit featuring screened in-porches, kitchenettes, and lake views.
