Kalahari Resorts Round Rock is America's Largest Indoor Waterpark Resort, a unique all-under-one-roof experience that offers wet-and-wild fun with world-class dining, a luxurious spa, live entertainment, diverse shopping experiences, a thrilling theme park and a state-of-the-art convention center. Kalahari Resorts are authentically African-themed, and the Round Rock resort shows a one-of-a-kind modern design evolution for the brand — an African resort with a Texas spirit. The Round Rock resort is Kalahari's first foray into Texas and the Southwest market.

 - Attractions include thrill rides, 250+ arcade games, ropes course, climbing walls, indoor zip line, bowling, laser tag, mini-golf and more.
- **Convention Center:** 200,000 sq. ft.
 - 2 ballrooms: 40,000 and 22,000 sq. ft.
 - 16 meeting rooms and multiple hospitality suites with flexible space.
 - Full-service business center.
 - Additional 50,000 sq. ft. of outdoor event space includes an event barn, covered terraces and lawn.
- **Spa Kalahari and Salon:** Body treatments, massage, skin care, nail care and hair services
 - Special offerings include halotherapy salt therapy, wet therapy room with a dry sauna, chromotherapy steam room, and brow and lash bar.

- **Food and Beverage:** 20 dining outlets, including Kalahari's signature steakhouse, Italian and Tex-Mex experiences, a buffet experience and many additional quick-bite options.
 - 4 signature full-service restaurants:
 - **Double Cut Charcoal Grill/Bourbon Bar** - Featuring premium cuts of meat, craft cocktails, family-style sides and more.
 - **Sortino's Italian Kitchen** - Includes Pizzeria Sortino, Sortino's Cafe & Gelato, and Enoteca wine lounge.
 - **Cinco Niños** - Modern Mexican and a tequila bar.
 - **B-Lux Grill & Bar** - Deliciously unique burgers and shakes handcrafted from scratch with fresh ingredients that are locally sourced.
 - **Great Karoo Marketplace Buffet** - Features multiple food stations, chef action stations, foods cooked from the display kitchen and picture-perfect pastry displays.
 - **Marrakesh Market Eatery** - A unique shopping experience inspired by the shops of Marrakesh. Mini storefronts offer art, souvenirs and to-go fare for breakfast, lunch and snacks.
 - **Redd's Piano Bar and Lounge** - Offers a diverse wine list, handcrafted cocktails and nightly live entertainment at 7 p.m.
 - **Java Manjaro** – Featuring hot and cold beverages and bites.
 - **Last Bite Candy Store** - Hand-dipped chocolate, fabulous caramel apples, homemade fudge, saltwater taffy, yummy ice cream and more.
 - **Waterpark Food and Drink** - Never leave the waterpark! Refuel with food and beverage outlets like the Zulu Grille, Cracked Coconut Bar and Paxton's Grotto adult swim-up bar.
- **Shopping:** 10,000 sq. ft. of retail space
 - Includes Amatuli outdoor marketplace with authentic African items. In spring 2021, Amatuli will include workshop tours with artists-in-residence, activities and more.
- **Design:** The authentic African theme was inspired by a Nelson family trip to the continent more than 20 years ago.
 - 1,000 pieces of African art, sculpture, furniture and retail items for the Round Rock resort were hand-selected by the Nelson family during an October 2019 visit to meet the artisans and entrepreneurs in South Africa, Ghana and Tanzania.
 - This \$600,000 art investment is part of an ongoing brand commitment to the people, places and cultures that inspire the resort.

- 22 life-size animal sculptures, including 12 elephants, 7 zebras, a mother and baby rhinoceros and a cape buffalo, welcome guests to the property and evoke a sense of an authentic African safari.
